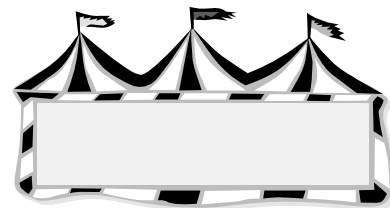
PASTOR'S CORNER:
