Ash Wednesday (February 21st) and Good Friday (April 6th) are days of fast and abstinence from meat. All other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat. The LAW OF FASTING binds all Catholics from their 18th birthday until their 59th birthday. FASTING means one full meal a day or two smaller meals not to equal a full meal. The LAW OF ABSTINENCE BINDS all Catholics 14 years and older.
