**PASTOR'S CORNER:** As I mentioned last week, the Ralph Stephenson Company is working on the church steeples which sustained damage from the lightening strike storm of July 15. Fortunately, our insurance is covering the cost which amounts to \$29,500. However, as you might have guessed, in the process of doing these repairs other things in need of repair were discovered. These added repairs are not covered by insurance because it is just normal wear and tear. The copper flashing at the base of the steeple has worn through and water is getting into the wood structure of the steeple. Obviously, this has to be fixed. The repairs will be a combination of rubber strips and copper flashing which is suppose to be more durable. The additional cost is \$7,500. I would be most grateful for any donations you might be able to make to cover this unexpected and added expense.
