Continuing our focus on the ten challenges issued to the Pro-Life movement made by Fr. Tom Euteneuer, President of Human Life International: Challenge Number two: *Fast for the conversion of abortion promoters – “Some demons are not driven out except by prayer and fasting,” said the Lord (Mt 17:21). A regular habit of tangible sacrifices for those most immersed in the grip of the abortion demon will erode the power of this evil. The Lord just needs an army of souls who are willing to embrace this practice – then astonishing results will abound. Why not go back to fasting or abstaining from meat every Friday for this cause?*

LENTEN REGULATIONS

Ash Wednesday (February 6) and Good Friday (March 21) are days of fast and abstinence. All other Fridays are days of abstinence only. Abstinence means no meat and applies to everyone 14 and older. The Law of Fasting pertains to all Catholics from 18 years of age to their 59th birthday. Fasting means one full meal a day or two lesser meals not to equal a full meal.
