Today is Divine Mercy Sunday. The visions of St. Faustina Kowalska, as recorded in her diary, show Jesus to be so rich in mercy. I encourage you to pick up the information about Divine Mercy, in the back of church. I offer the following quote from St. Faustina's Diary for your reflection: "Write, speak of My mercy. Tell souls where they are to look for solace; that is, in the Tribunal of Mercy. There the greatest miracles take place [and] are incessantly repeated...reveal to him one's misery, and the miracle of Divine Mercy will be fully demonstrated. Were a soul like a decaying corpse so that from a human standpoint, there would be no [hope of] restoration and everything would already be lost, it is not so with God. The miracle of Divine Mercy restores that soul in full. Oh, how miserable are those who do not take advantage of the miracle of God's mercy! You will call out in vain, but it will be too late. (1448)"

Continuing our focus on the ten challenges issued to the Pro-Life movement made by Fr. Tom Euteneuer, President of Human Life International: Challenge Number Nine: *Reject politicians who believe in rape, incest, life-of-the-mother and fetal deformity "exceptions – political candidates who believe that these "exceptions" are legitimate are really saying that it's okay to kill some babies and save others.
