Christmas and New Years Masses:

Christmas Day and the Solemnity of Mary the Mother of God on New Year's Day fall on Saturdays this year. We will have the normal schedule of Masses for Christmas. But, since Christmas Day is on a Saturday, there will not be a Saturday afternoon 4:30 pm Mass. So, you will have to attend Mass for the Sunday, December 26. on Sunday itself at either the 9am, 11am, or 7pm Mass.

Now, the Solemnity of Mary the Mother of God on Saturday, January 1, is not a holy day of obligation this year because it falls on a Saturday.
