from the Pastor's Desk

Remembering the Dead: Traditionally, November is the month in which we remember in special and practical ways the deceased members of our families, our deceased friends and all of the faithful departed.

I want to take this opportunity to correct a popular misconception about what happens after a person dies. Too many people believe that when a loved one dies the soul automatically goes to heaven. Well, maybe yes, maybe no. That a loved one is in heaven is our hope, of course. But we do not know the state of a person’s soul when he or she dies, only God knows. No matter what we think or want, we are not “the Judge,” only God is.

When a person dies in a state of grace but the soul is not completely prepared to enter heaven, then he or she is placed in Purgatory for purification. (God forbid that a person should die outside of the state of grace, that is, with unconfessed, unrepented mortal sins on the soul.)

So, what we should be doing for the deceased is praying that our hope of salvation and eternal life with the Lord will be realized in them. Hence, we ought to pray for and offer our sufferings for the repose of all souls.

Christmas and New Years Masses:

Christmas Day and the Solemnity of Mary the Mother of God on New Years Day fall on Saturdays this year. We will have the normal schedule of Masses for Christmas. But, since Christmas Day is on a Saturday, there will not be a Saturday afternoon 4:30 pm Mass. So, you will have to attend Mass for the Sunday, December 26. on Sunday itself at either the 9am, 11am, or 7pm Mass.

Now, the Solemnity of Mary the Mother of God on Saturday, January 1, is not a holy day of obligation this year because it falls on a Saturday. So, Masses on Friday, December 31, New Years Eve will be only the daily morning Masses at 8am and 9am and the only Mass for the Solemnity of Mary the Mother of God will be January 1 at 8am. However, even though Saturday is New Years Day we will have the full complement of Masses for the weekend so, there will be on New Years Day the regular Saturday 4:30 pm Mass and on Sunday, January 2, the normal Mass schedule: 9am, 11am and 7pm.
