If you qualify for the Earned Income Tax Credit, you will receive additional cash back. Your return will be e-filed and you can expect your money back in 10-15 days. Elder High School, which is handicap accessible, is one of the many free tax preparation sites in Cincinnati. February 6th, 13th, March 6th, 20th, and April 10th, from 9am – 12pm (walk-ins accepted on these dates). and February 27th and March 13th and 27th, from 3pm – 6pm, (no walk-ins accepted on these dates).
