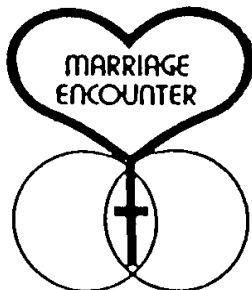

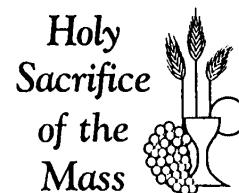
from the Pastor's Desk

Thank You! Again, I thank you for your continued generosity toward the appeal for the St. Lawrence School's Education Fund. Last Sunday, we received an additional \$2,250.94 for the Education Fund. That brings the total to \$43,813.67. Your generosity has been tremendous! By the way, enrollment this year is 231 students in K-8 and 29 pre-school students, with a waiting list.

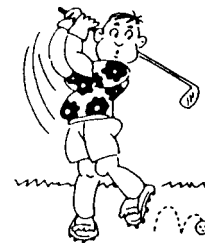
