Thank You! Last Sunday, we received an additional \$3089.30 for the Education Fund. That brings the total to \$39,752.73. Today, we will resume the second collection for the Education Fund. Your generosity has been tremendous!

From the Finance Committee

When the Finance Committee met back in the spring to look at the Parish/School budget for 2010-11 it was apparent that we faced a deficit of nearly \$160,000. In mid-April we began the weekly second collection for the Education Fund with our promise to review our situation after June 30. Your very generous response to this appeal has generated over \$35,000! OVERWHELMING!! THANK YOU!!

Reviewing our deficit of 2009-10 and the prospect for the new school year of 2010-11, it looks as though our finances have improved. The staff's salaries were frozen. Registrations for K-8 and preschool have increased. However, we will not have a total number for the students in our school until September.

We received word that St. Lawrence will be the beneficiary of a \$25,000 bequest, which is also a blessing we did not previously expect!

It now appears that our predicted loss has been cut by more than half to \$66,100. This loss is still more than we can sustain. Therefore, we, the Finance Committee, have asked that we re-start the weekly second collection for the Education Fund the last weekend in August. We are confident that you will again respond generously.

In the near future, we should receive information regarding our parish application to the CISE program and several grant requests to local foundations.
