**Why A Fortnight for Freedom?** From June 21-July 4, the U. S. Catholic bishops are recognizing a "Fortnight for Freedom" to draw special attention to current threats to religious liberty. One concrete example of this challenge is the mandate by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services for religious institutions, such as universities, hospitals, and charitable organizations, to facilitate access to contraception, sterilization and abortion-inducing drugs, which would be contrary to their beliefs. It is an unprecedented action by the federal government to define which religious institutions are "religious enough" to merit protection of their religious liberty. The Fortnight for Freedom is an opportunity for people of all faiths to remember that we should not confine our faith to just the worship space, but we have a human right to bring it to the public square for the common good of all who live in this land. Below are some suggestions to participate in the Fortnight for Freedom: 1) make a Holy Hour (Eucharistic Adoration here on Thursday, June 28 from 3-5pm), 2) attend daily Mass, 3) skip a meal, 4) give up something, 5) make a sacrifice, 6) pray a rosary, 7) fast for one day or 8) go without meat for a day. Please make a commitment to do one or more of these between now and July 4.
