The International Pilgrim Statue Of Our Lady of Fatima

The world famous International Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima was sculpted in 1947 by Jose Thedim, based on the description of Sr. Lucia, one of the three seers who saw Our Lady each month from May to October 1917 in Fatima, Portugal.

The Pilgrim Virgin Statue will visit Saint Peter in Chains Cathedral on Tuesday, August 14, 2012, the day before the feast of the Assumption. The visit will begin with a procession and Mass at 11:30am followed by a brief talk, the praying of the rosary and the Litany to the Blessed Virgin Mary. Private prayer throughout the day is encouraged, ending with a recessional at 5:00pm.
