## from the Pastor's Desk

**Father visits his mother, again:** Today, Sunday, January 15, after the 9 o'clock Mass, I will be one my way to visit my mother in Oklahoma City. I will be back for Masses on the last weekend of January. While I'm away, Father Westerhoff will have the weekend Masses and the 9 o'clock daily Masses. Instead of Masses, Sister Helen Julia will have Communion Services at 8 o'clock. Now, if the weather is bad and school is closed, the Communion Service and the 9 o'clock Mass will be cancelled. St. Lawrence closes her school according to what the Oak Hills Schools do. So, if you see that the Oak Hills Schools are closed due to weather, then St. Lawrence School is also closed and the Communion Service and Mass for that morning will be cancelled.

**Eucharistic Adoration:** On Thursday, January 19 and 26, Eucharistic Adoration will be cancelled. It will resume on Thursday, February 2.

### Our Display Sign for Hymn & Response

**Numbers:** As you know, we have an electronic red sign at the left front of church for displaying hymn numbers. Because of the new music settings for the Mass, Mr. Schaedle, our organist, is going to try the following procedure for the time being:

If you see numerical digits in the right-hand segment of the display, and nothing else, it refers to the hymn number in the red "We Celebrate" hymnal.

If you see numerical digits in the right-hand segment of the display plus the letter "G" in the left hand segment, it refers to the hymn number in the green "Gather" hymnal.

If you see two numerical digits in the left hand segment of the display, it refers to the PAGE number in the new, small, red "Revised Order of Mass" booklets.

### **Archdiocesan Lay Ministry Formation:**

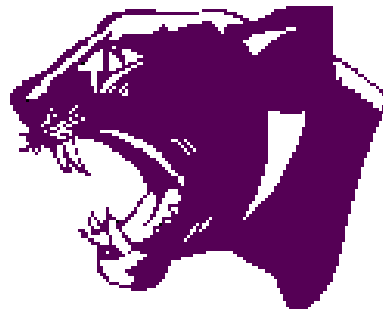
