LENTEN REGULATIONS

Ash Wednesday (February 13) and Good Friday (March 29) are days of fast and abstinence. All other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence only. The law of abstinence applies to everyone 14 years of age and older. Abstinence means no meat. The Law of Fasting pertains to all Catholics from 18 years of age to their 59th birthday. Fasting means limiting your food to a single full meal.
