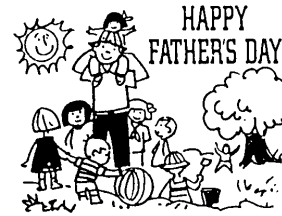

The event was launched last year in the wake of what Catholic leaders viewed as mounting attacks on religious freedom throughout the country and the world. The need for prayer, education, and action in defense of religious liberty has never been greater. "The Fortnight for Freedom exists to meet that need. This year's Fortnight occurs just weeks before August 1, when the administration's mandate coercing us to violate our deeply-held beliefs will be enforced against most religious non-profits. During the Fortnight the Supreme Court's decisions on the definition of marriage will likely be handed down as well.
