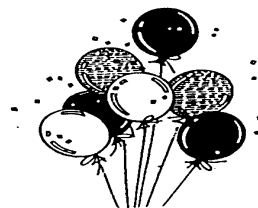


Easter Blessings!!! I want to wish each of you a very Happy and Glorious Easter.
